We are Law Graduates for Sensible Bar Admission (LGSBA), a group recently co-founded by two 2020 graduates of the Georgetown University Law Center. We are a nationwide group of July 2020 bar applicants seeking legal representation, either on a nationwide or state-by-state basis, to assist us in filing lawsuits against various state boards of law examiners, as well as against the National Conference of Bar Examiners.

Our goal is to organize our members into classes by jurisdiction and subsequently pair these classes of bar applicants with licensed attorneys or legal organizations willing to provide legal representation.

Since launching just Wednesday night, membership forms have been pouring in and appear to be increasing exponentially. We currently have close to 150 members applying to bars in at least 33 jurisdictions: AL, AZ, CA, CO, CT, DC, FL, GA, ID, IL, IN, KY, MD, MA, MI, MN, MS, MO, MT, NE, NH, NJ, NY, NC, OH, OK, OR, PA, TN, TX, VA, WV, and WI. We expect this list to continue expanding. We hope to catalyze lawsuits against bar examiners in each of these jurisdictions.

We are interested in pursuing any and all claims that bar applicants may have against these organizations and their respective directors and officers. We are especially interested in obtaining 1) declaratory judgment that bar examiners' waivers of liability for in-person exams are void, 2) injunctive relief prohibiting the administration of unsafe and inequitable in-person exams, 3) injunctive relief prohibiting untested and inequitable online exams, 4) injunctive relief requiring states to institute emergency diploma privilege – as this is currently the only reasonable and humane path to legal licensure, and/or 5) obtaining any monetary damages possible to compensate for any harm caused by bar examiners' mishandling of the July 2020 bar exam.
